Our dinner will be prepared by Chef Lionel from the French Club in collaboration with Chef Jean-Michel Carrette, Chef-Owner of the acclaimed one Michelin star restaurant, Aux Terrasses in Tournus. Chef Carrette is traveling from France exclusively for this event and will prepare several special dishes just for us.

Aubert de Villaine of Domaine de la Romanée-Conti and Brice de la Morandière of Domaine Leflaive have selected wines to accompany our dinner and will be present to introduce their selections and discuss them with us. Our evening will begin with an aperitif of Champagne Delamotte Blancs de Blancs, followed by a concert. As music is central to our mission, this performance will be one of the highlights of the evening, featuring notable musicians as well as one or more of the "young talents" whose careers have been aided by FOMV, all under the direction of our Artistic Director, David Chan.

We will conclude the night with an auction of other extraordinary wines and experiences, including Jeroboams of the 2022 Corton Charlemagne Grand Cru, Cuvée du Roi Soleil.

Magnums are available for future delivery (late 2024 or early 2025) and additional U.S. domestic shipping charges may apply.

ABOUT FRIENDS OF MUSIQUE ET VIN

Friends of Musique et Vin au Clos Vougeot, Inc. was founded in 2019. In the fall of 2019, its inaugural event was held at the French Consulate in New York City, where funds were raised to commission a violin by Master luthier Sam Zygmuntowicz. In the fall of 2020, during the height of Covid when all music and cultural institutions in New York City were shut down, FOMV held a virtual fundraiser and concert at the Clos Vougeot, and used a portion of the proceeds to help musicians who had lost their income. In 2022, FOMV held successful gala dinners in New York and San Francisco. In April 2023, auditions were held at Juilliard to select the musician who will perform with the violin commissioned by FOMV, retaining this special instrument on a multi-year loan basis.

The net proceeds from the 2024 San Francisco Gala will be used to further FOMV's goals of supporting musical concerts including cross-cultural exchanges including between the US and France, training and supporting young musicians, and supporting production of musical instruments to be loaned to those young musicians. Amounts received will be tax deductible to the extent permitted by law.

FOMV also provides support to the French non-profit association Musique & Vin au Clos Vougeot (MVCV), including sponsorships of the final gala concerts during MVCV's annual music festival organized in Burgundy. MVCV was created in 2008 by Aubert de Villaine and Bernard Hervet with an exceptional mission: to create a fusion between musicians of international fame, winegrowers and passionate collectors of Burgundy. It offers an amplified experience to its patrons - a pleasure that appeals to both the ears and the palate, around an annual, ten-day festival of wine tastings and concerts, culminating at the historic Clos Vougeot - and receives some of the biggest names in the world of music and opera. Activities of MVCV also include creation of a collection of violins, violas and cellos lent to promising young musicians; funding scholarships to young musicians for travel and lessons; and organization of an annual free public concert at "Les Halles" in Beaune promoting these young talented musicians.
